As you will be fully aware there are a series of planned strikes that will affect the entire rail network on 21st, 23rd and 25th June. In addition to this, there is planned strike action that will affect the tube network on Tuesday 21st June. Given our central London location, and the heavy use of the rail and tube network for both staff and students, we will unfortunately have to close on Tuesday 21st June and will only be open to Year 11 and Year 13 students sitting public examinations, and students within our Resource Base. All other students will work from home, completing tasks that will be uploaded onto Google Classroom. Your son will have work that covers a full timetabled day of lessons to complete.

Plans for Wednesday 22nd June

We will reopen on Wednesday 22nd June (usual opening and closing times), when I will write to you again regarding the planned strike action for Thursday 23rd June. At the moment it is impossible to predict the disruption that the strike action will create, however, the tube network should be fully operational.

Finally, I do understand the disruption caused by the school closure and the impact this has on our community, however, I'm sure you can appreciate we have exhausted every possible alternative.
