Dear Families,

As stated in my letter dated Friday 17<sup>th</sup> June, I am writing to provide an update on the arrangements for school for the remainder of this week. As you will be fully aware following the strike action yesterday, Tuesday 21<sup>st</sup> June, further strike action is scheduled for tomorrow, Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> June and Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> June.

This will undoubtedly create significant disruption for students and teachers commuting into central London. We will therefore need to modify our school days slightly for the remainder of this week only, to ensure that staff and students have more time to commute into school safely.

Please see below for details of our arrangements for Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> and Friday 24<sup>th</sup> June:

**Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> June (09:40am - 2:00pm)**

- Years 7, 8, 9, and 10 will be expected onto the school site for the start of period 2 from 09:40 hrs. All students will leave the school site at 2:00pm. (Break and Lunch service will be at the same time as normal).
- **Year 12 students will work from home**, completing tasks that will be uploaded onto Google Classroom
- **All Year 11 and 13 students sitting public examinations are expected onto the school site for 8:45am.**

**Friday 24<sup>th</sup> June (9:40 - 3:00pm)**

- All Year groups 7, 8, 9, 10, 12 will again be expected onto the school site for the start of period 2 from 09:40 hrs. (Break and Lunch service will be at the same time as normal).
- The school day will end at the normal published time of 3:00pm.
