Dear Families,

As we come towards the end of term and the Christmas break, it is clear that it will be well-deserved by the staff and students alike. A huge amount has happened in these few months. We have had a number of extra-curricular activities that have enabled students to engage fully in their learning. As always, it has been great to see our students enjoying educational trips and visits and accessing the range of extra-curricular clubs on offer. We have welcomed a number of visitors to the school with The Royal Navy kicking off the year with our new Year 7's in August, introducing them to LNS through a range of team building activities - they have also worked with our Year 8 cohort and will be returning throughout this academic year. Standard Expectations:

the standard set of expectations we will have all students:

• Full school uniform must be worn to and from school.

• Shoes must be plain black, have no tags, and must be polishable.

• Black or navy coats with no logos (not to be worn in school).

• No hoodies.

A suitably sized navy or black school bag. Pouches are not permitted.

• Hair must be of a straightforward style, clear of the collar and ears.

• No lines in hair or eyebrows.

No earrings or jewellery are to be worn.

Mobile phones are allowed in school but may not be out at any time. All pupils will be

asked to switch their phones off before entering the school site. If they are seen in

corridors etc. they will be confiscated.
