Dear Families,

Ahead of the Coronation of Their Majesties King Charles III and Queen Camilla on 6<sup>th</sup> May 2023 can I remind families to please check their sons travel arrangements on the <u>3<sup>rd</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> May 2023</u> as rehearsals and preparations are taking place for the day's events. The Coronation is an historic and rare occasion, so I do hope families take the opportunity to talk to their sons about the significance of the celebration.

There are planned road closures in the Westminster and Waterloo areas so families may wish to allow some extra time to get to school on those days. More information can be <u>found here:</u>

#### School day.

We have had a very successful start to our new arrangements for the school day, please see a reminder of those arrangements below.

#### Start of Day Arrangements (Yr. 7, 8 and 9)

- 08:30 am Expectation that all students will be onsite (whistle will be blown at 08:35 am).
  Students will line up in their period 1 classes in the playground.
- 08:37 am All students will be met in the playground by their period 1 teacher and then escorted to their lesson for an 08:40 start.

### Start of the Day Arrangements (Yr. 10, 11, 12 and 13)

- 08:30 am Expectation that all students will be onsite (whistle will be blown at 08:35 am).
- 08:37 am Students will go directly to period 1 arriving before 8:40 am. Teachers will be present in the corridor to welcome students.

### **School Uniform and Standard Expectations:**

As we continue to improve standards, I must re-emphasise the standard set of expectations we have of all students:

- Full school uniform must be worn to and from school.
- Shoes must be plain black, have no tags, and must be polishable.
- Black or navy coats with no logos (not to be worn in school).
- No hoodies.
- A suitably sized navy or black school bag. Pouches are not permitted.
- Hair must be of a straightforward style, clear of the collar and ears.

• No lines in hair or eyebrows.

• No earrings or jewellery are to be worn.

Mobile phones are allowed in school and must not be out at any time.

All pupils will be asked to switch their phones off before entering the school site.

• If mobile phones are seen in corridors, classroom, communal areas etc., they will be confiscated.

**Bank holidays** 

The school will be closed to <u>ALL</u> pupils on Monday 1<sup>st</sup> May 2023 and on the Monday 8<sup>th</sup> May 2023 as both these days are public holidays.

Strike Day 2<sup>nd</sup> May 2023

The school will be closed on the 2<sup>nd</sup> May 2023 to all pupils but for Year 11 and 13. The timetable for these pupils is at the end of this letter. Work for all other students will be loaded onto Google Classroom. If you do need to send your son into school on 2<sup>nd</sup> May 2023 please complete the <u>form here</u>. Break and lunch service will be provided for students in school on the strike day.

**Hire Bicycles** 

We have now received communication from Lime Hire indicating that it is illegal for under 18's to use their hire bikes. Therefore, all students under the age of 18 are no longer permitted to hire bikes in their commute to or from school.
