Dear Families,

After another incredibly busy few weeks we have closed the term with public examinations for our year 11 and 13 students. The students have worked incredibly hard and acquitted themselves well and I look forward to some very strong results being announced over the summer holidays.

#### School day

The new arrangements for the start of the school have proven to be incredibly successful; we have seen a marked reduction in the number of late arriving pupils and an improvement in corridor behaviours. As a reminder when we return from half term these arrangements are:

#### Start of Day Arrangements (Yr. 7, 8 and 9)

- 08:30 am Expectation that all students will be onsite (whistle will be blown at 08:35 am) Students will line up in their period 1 classes in the playground.
- 08:37 am All students will be met in the playground by their period 1 teacher and then escorted to their lesson for an 08:40 start.

#### Start of the Day Arrangements (Yr. 10, 11, 12 and 13)

- 08:30 am Expectation that all students will be onsite (whistle will be blown at 08:35 am).
- 08:37 am Students will go directly to period 1 arriving before 8:40 am. (Teachers will be present in the corridor to welcome students).

#### **School Uniform and Standard Expectations**

As we continue to improve standards, I must re-emphasise the standard set of expectations we have of all students:

- Full school uniform must be worn to and from school.
- Shoes must be plain black, have no tags, and must be polishable.
- Black or navy coats with no logos (not to be worn in school).
- No hoodies.
- A suitably sized navy or black school bag. Pouches are not permitted.
- Hair must be of a straightforward style, clear of the collar and ears.
- No lines in hair or eyebrows.

- No earrings or jewellery are to be worn.
- Mobile phones are allowed in school and must not be out at any time.
- All pupils will be asked to switch their phones off before entering the school site.
- If mobile phones are seen in corridors, classroom, communal areas etc., they will be confiscated.

### Hire Bicycles

We have now received communication from Lime Hire indicating that it is illegal for under 18's to use their hire bikes. Therefore, all students under the age of 18 are no longer permitted to hire bikes in their commute to or from school.

We look forward to welcoming our new year 7 students in September 2023, each student will receive support for their uniform jumper and beret of £70; if families have not yet confirmed a place for their son we do still have a few places left in year 7 and spaces also in years 8 & 9.
