Dear Families,

As we look forward to a well-deserved two week break for students and staff, I would like to take this opportunity to thank you all for your continued support of the school. As always, it really has been a busy first term and I could not be prouder of the efforts of all staff and students who have contributed to such a successful start to this academic year. As outlined in my opening communication at the start of the year, we made some changes to the start of the school day that have significantly improved the punctuality and attendance to school, whilst also providing a productive start to the school day. This is evidenced through the large number of boys across all year groups that have managed to make it into their year groups 'Top 10'. Our culture of 'Positive Reward' is further demonstrated in the 24,607 achievement points awarded across all year groups. Congratulations to all students for their achievements this term.

Free School Meal Vouchers

For eligible families, free school meal vouchers will be delivered by email on the 23rd and 30th October, each to a value of £20.00 (£40.00 in total).

Lunchtimes

We have made some improvements to the lunchtime experience for our students, with each year group now sitting together, one year group at a time. to meet and socialise over their meal. Please note, students are NOT permitted to purchase drinks only / and or a dessert selection only - we insist that each student has a balanced meal, and we are monitoring those students who do not eat regularly at lunch time. Please support the school by reinforcing healthy eating habits at home and if your son does have a packed lunch ensuring this is nutritionally balanced.

Water Bottles

All students have now been issued with reusable water bottles helping the school reduce its impact on the environment. Please only send your sons with water to drink throughout the school day. Under no circumstance should your son bring fizzy drinks and plastic bottles onto the school site.

School Uniform and Standard Expectations

We have noticed a significant improvement in the standards of student uniform since our return to school in September. As we approach the winter months can I remind all families that hoodies are prohibited and should not be worn into school. Please can I also ask that you check your sons' trousers to make sure they fasten correctly and have a belt which means that they remain at waste level:

- Full school uniform must be worn to and from school.
- Shoes must be plain black, have no tags, and must be polishable.
- Black or navy coats with no logos (not to be worn in school).
- No hoodies.
- A suitably sized navy or black school bag. Pouches are not permitted.
- Hair must be of a straightforward style, clear of the collar and ears.
- No lines in hair or eyebrows.
- No earrings or jewellery are to be worn.
- Mobile phones are allowed in school and must not be out at any time.
- All pupils will be asked to switch their phones off before entering the school site.
- If mobile phones are seen in corridors, classroom or communal areas, they will be confiscated.
