### **School Uniform and Standard Expectations**

We have noticed a significant improvement in the standards of student uniform since our return to school in September. As we look forward to the new year, can I remind all families that hoodies are prohibited and should not be worn into school. Please can I also ask that you check your sons trousers to make sure they fasten correctly and have a belt which means that they remain at waste level:

- Full school uniform must be worn to and from school.
- Shoes must be plain black, have no tags, and must be polishable.
- Black or navy coats with no logos (not to be worn in school).
- No hoodies.
- A suitably sized navy or black school bag. Pouches are not permitted.
- Hair must be of a straightforward style, clear of the collar and ears.
- No lines in hair or eyebrows.
- No earrings or jewellery are to be worn.
- Mobile phones are allowed in school and must not be out at any time.
- All pupils will be asked to switch their phones off before entering the school site.
- If mobile phones are seen in corridors, classroom or communal areas, they will be confiscated.

PPE's will commence from Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> January 2024 for our Year 11 students. Please encourage your son to revise and work hard in preparation for these very important exams.
