



There are 5 lessons each day. Each learning session is 1 hour, with live content for 45 minutes.

Lessons should include live content as much as possible. Live content can include:

### Full online lesson

Students will work with the teacher online on Meet for 45 minutes with a mixture of teacher input and students working.

### Low Stakes Quizzes

Students participate in a quiz altogether as a class which is self-marked or answers given to students instantly.

### Department Individuality

Some departments will have other ways of delivering content which is unique to them.

### Live Feedback

Teachers will set work online on Google Docs or Slides where they can see the work that students complete in real time and give feedback to students as they are working.

### Videos

Teachers may prepare a video before the lesson that has specific times for students to pause and answer questions where teachers can then provide feedback

### Q and A

Students are set work to do, with teachers reading out answers or tips throughout the lessons and students asking questions of the teacher through the chat in Meet.

### Use of external lessons

Teachers may play an external lesson (e.g. Oak Academy) during their online lesson with pause points for questions.

### Explain

The teacher will explain the key points in the lesson, take questions and then set independent work, remaining in the lesson for students who need help.
