Year 11, 12 and 13 Exams

Dear Parent / Carer,

As you are aware, following the Prime Minister's announcement on the 4th January, we have entered a new phase of school closures. The week commencing 11th January was due to be our Pre Public Examinations (mocks) for our year 11, 12 and 13 pupils. Due to the school closure these examinations have now been postponed and will be rescheduled for later in the year. Students in these year groups will continue with their online learning as outlined in the remote learning letter.

However, there are some public examinations scheduled for the January examination series and it has been confirmed by OFQUAL that these exams will still take place the week commencing the 11th January. The students who have been entered for these exams will be receiving an updated timetable this week. **Students will be required only to be on site for their exam, to arrive at least 10 minutes prior to the start of the exam through the main reception. Students are to be reminded that they must maintain social distancing, wear masks in communal areas and regularly sanitise their hands.**
