Dear Families.

I have lost count of the number of times I have written to you emphasising what an extraordinary term it has been, but here we are once again! As ever, I am so proud of all our students - in the resilience they have shown and the dedication demonstrated towards their learning. I fully appreciate that five hours of remote learning each day is incredibly challenging, not only for the students but for the whole family and I would like to thank you for the support you have provided your son / daughter, this really has been a collective effort! I would also like to thank the amazing efforts of my staff; their efforts to provide the very best remote education; the support offered through the on-site learning; the 1000's of phone calls made during the term; home visits to students; mentoring and check-in sessions - I really couldn't ask to lead a more committed group of staff.

As you may be aware, the Prime Minister has indicated that it is his intention to start reopening schools from the 8<sup>th</sup> March 2021. He is due to give a further announcement on the 22<sup>nd</sup> February 2021 where he will provide more specific details as to what this will entail. Therefore, after half-term all students will continue to follow their remote learning timetable through Google Classroom. I will of course write to you with the schools plans for a wider reopening once these details are made available.

## Onsite Provision (From Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> February 2021)

We will continue to operate our on-site provision for children of key workers and all other eligible students. Covid 19 - Arrangements for Positive cases during the February Half-Term Holiday

As part of our continuing support for families during the February half-term break, we will be

monitoring our school email should families wish to report an instance of a positive case over the

first part of the week. This is of particular importance for those students that have been using our

on-site school provision. If your son provides a positive test between the 12<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup> February

2021 please email the school at "admin@LNS.org.uk" and provide details of your son's name

and registration group and the last day they were in school.

Please DO NOT telephone the school as the phones will not be monitored.

This information is of paramount importance as it will allow the school to advise other students

who MAY have come into contact with a positive case before the end of the school term so they

can isolate and help stop the spread of the virus.
