To become a Lambeth foster carer, there are only a few basic criteria you must meet. You must:

- be over 21 years old
- have a spare bedroom
- be a full-time resident in the UK or have indefinite leave to remain
- have good spoken and written English

You don't have to own your own home and we welcome couples or individuals from every walk of life. Your fostering journey could take between 2 – 4 months to progress, following the steps below:

Step 1: Make an enquiry Step 2: We'll do your assessment Step 3: You'll attend our fostering panel Step 4: You become a foster carer
