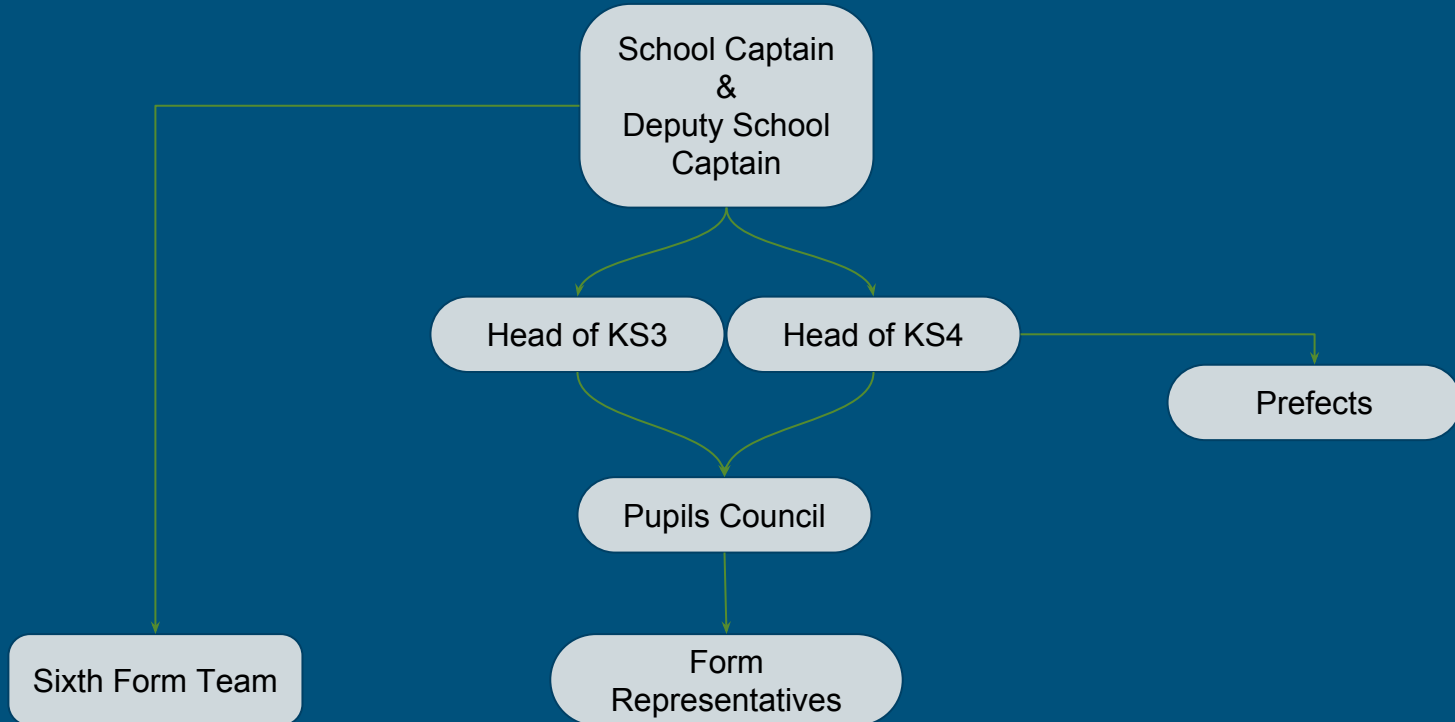
This Team is lead by students, and is coordinated by Ms Gonzalez.
