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Year 12/13 Home Learning 2023 - 2024

Home learning is an important part of our Sixth Form. Students cannot hope to achieve just by completing classwork. Students will be set a <u>minimum</u> of 2 hours home learning each week for each option. It is recommended that students completing an A level course of study complete 5 hours of additional home learning each week per course. Examples of how this 5 hours should be made up are below

- Home learning tasks set by the teachers
- Independent research, commonly known as reading around the subject
- Revising the weeks learning to aid memory retention

Homework will be set on google classroom and parents are invited to access the google classroom and monitor the home learning that is being set.

The majority of students in the sixth form have study periods where they can be completing their home learning. Students can use the Sixth form Study rooms and the school library for quiet study and for completing homework. Students who are not involved in the football academy or doing Maritime also have Wednesdays during which they can complete their home learning.
