

As part of the school's literacy drive, for students with significant difficulties we are running Lexia CORE5 Reading & Lexia PowerUp Literacy. These are computer-based programmes that tailor activities to the student's specific level of reading. The programme focuses on three areas: word study, grammar and comprehension. Activities are adapted according to progress and staff overseeing the programme intervene with tutoring on key areas of difficulty as required.

The recommended time is 90 minutes per week across three or four sessions. To minimise disruption to learning we have scheduled sessions to take place as per below timetable.

3. Students should complete the tasks independently. This is important because the programme provides extra support and instruction if students struggle with a task and alerts staff when further help is required.
