



Pupil Online learning code of conduct

Pupils are held responsible for their behaviour. Disruptive or abusive behaviour towards anyone will not be tolerated at any level.

- All pupils must behave in a respectful, considerate and kind manner when they are in classrooms. They must listen to and take direction from their teacher when in class
- If a child demonstrates behaviour that the teacher deems to be unacceptable or inappropriate the teacher will follow the school behaviour systems, with warnings being given, contacting parents if necessary, and logging incidents on Classcharts.
- Pupils are expected to participate actively in lessons and complete tasks to the best of your ability. Teachers will provide encouragement and we expect pupils to try their very best.
- You should only access the lesson using your school email address. Other email addresses will not be accepted. Usernames and photos must be appropriate.
- Usual safeguarding protocols will be followed if your teachers notice anything inappropriate during the video.
- Attendance from all students is advised, to maintain progress in the subject. If you can't attend the lesson please email your teacher beforehand with your.
- If attending, pupils must be punctual to lessons. It is the responsibility of the pupil, parents and carers to ensure that a suitable device, to access lessons, is charged, has a good internet connection and is in good working order.
- Students must be in an appropriate location.
- Recorded lessons are for the sole use of helping students to learn. They must not be used for any other purpose.
- Contact with any participant of the lesson is at their discretion. Students will not attempt to contact teachers outside the school permitted channels.
