Dear parents and carers,

In line with Governmental advice and as per our previous messages we will keep London Nautical School open on a partial basis to support our most vulnerable pupils and those pupils whose family members may be key or critical workers as defined by the Government.

Through the course of next week (w/c 23<sup>rd</sup> march 2020) school will be open from 08:40 hrs to 15:00 hrs. (There will be no detentions or trips.) A hot meal will be served at lunchtime from a reduced menu. The school office will be open on a reduced basis - you can contact school in an emergency on 0207 928 6801 or via email at admin@lns.org.uk.

If your child is in school next week then there is no requirement to wear a school uniform. The usual school timetable will be collapsed with students required to complete work on Google Classroom and additional activities provided by the school.

For absent students, work will be posted on google classroom and the staff will set and monitor work remotely - if you have a problem accessing google classroom please email school at **admin@Ins.org.uk** and put "googleclassroom" in the subject line.
